Group Volunteer Opportunities

COOKING MEALS

Description: Cook nutritious meals for children in the Crisis Shelter supervised by our full-time cook staff. Meals will be batch cooked for use during the month.

Frequency: Once per month

Group size: Maximum 3 volunteers

Suggested Cost: \$150

Additional Info: This opportunity takes place monthly and scheduling can be accommodated to the group's needs.

BAKING GROUP

Description: Bake snacks and treats for children in the Crisis Shelter supervised by our full-time cook staff. Baking will be batch cooked for use during the month. For special occasion months – additional baking support will be needed (eg. Halloween, Christmas, Easter)

Frequency: Once per month Group size: Maximum 3 volunteers / 5 in special months Suggested Cost: \$150 Additional Info: This opportunity takes place monthly and scheduling can be accommodated to the group's needs.

ORGANIZING/CLEANING STORAGE GARAGE

Description: Help organize and fully clean our garage that contains our necessary supplies and donations. This opportunity will be supervised by Volunteer Coordinator and Donations Associate.

Frequency: 2-3 times (Yearly)

Group size: 2 – 10 volunteers

Suggested Cost: \$0

Additional Info: This opportunity requires some heavy lifting and moving. This opportunity will expose individuals to some dust and dirt from cleaning; precautions for safe cleaning (e.g. masks, gloves) are recommended. Individuals with breathing restrictions are not recommended for this opportunity.

PLAYGROUND CLEANING

Description: Remove/Replace old sand with new sand ****New sand 2023 (replace 2025)**.** Clean playground and equipment and outdoor space for the children. Fix/Replace needed outdoor items (e.g. rubber mats, toys). This opportunity will be supervised by Volunteer Coordinator

Frequency: 2 times Spring/Fall (Yearly)

Group size: Maximum of 20 volunteers

Suggested Cost: \$500

Additional Info: This opportunity requires physical labour and pressure washer/outdoor cleaning supplies (e.g. window cleaners).

<u>COURTYARD</u>

Description: Clean courtyard, equipment and outdoor space for the children. Fix/Replace needed outdoor items (e.g. rubber mats, toys). Clean ball pit for children. This opportunity will be supervised by Volunteer Coordinator/Crisis Shelter staff

Frequency: Yearly

Group size: Maximum of 10 volunteers

Suggested Cost: \$300

Additional Info: This opportunity requires physical labour and pressure washer/outdoor cleaning supplies (e.g. window cleaners).

CLEANING (General)

Description: Help clean the outdoor/indoor spaces of both the Admin building and Crisis Shelter. We need a group of volunteers to deep clean/wash outdoor siding, windows, concrete, planters, railings, signage, walls, toys, shelves, rooms, etc. This opportunity will be supervised by Volunteer Coordinator

Frequency: 2-3 months (dependent on need/area of focus, e.g. kitchen)

Group size: Maximum of 20 volunteers

Suggested Cost: \$250

Additional Info: This opportunity requires physical labour and may require pressure washer/outdoor cleaning supplies (e.g. window cleaners)

GARDENING/PLANTING (Admin)

Description: Come and plant flowers, vegetables, and herbs at Kids Kottage gardens at both Administration and Crisis Shelter. This opportunity will be supervised by Volunteer Coordinator Frequency: Once in April/May to plant in gardens, One-time clean-up in October (preferably before snow)

Group size: 5-10 volunteers

Suggested Cost: Approximately \$500 for flower/garden supplies

DECK STAINING/REFINISHING **COMPLETED IN SUMMER 2023 (redo in 2025)**

Description: Help stain and refinish the deck the children use outdoors in the playground area. This opportunity will be supervised by Volunteer Coordinator and Program Manager

Frequency: Every second year

Group size: Maximum 10 volunteers

Suggested Cost: \$500

Additional Info: Group who has members with experience deck refinishing will be given priority. Some experience and labour is required for this opportunity.

GARDENING (Maintenance)

Description: Maintain and re-plant the gardens through the spring and summer months. This opportunity will be supervised by the Volunteer Coordinator Frequency: Once per month, in spring and summer (weather permitting)
